FAMILY MONEY chased the pace, made a run at the lead on the turn, was outmoved by the winner, then finished willingly to prove second best. BILL IS IN LOVE unhurried after breaking slowly, passed tired rivals to gain the show. ALL TRUE tired from good position. IRIE SENSATION chased the pace along the rail, was checked twice in tight quarters on the turn and faltered. PLEASE BILL off slowly, was outrun. NASHUA'S LAUNCH was no factor while racing three wide. ROAD EXPRESS stumbled at the start, moved up quickly to set the pace, angled to the inside on the turn and faded.
