WYATT'S WOMEN rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, rallied to reach even terms for command with BABA'S MANDATE at the sixteenth pole, then just edged that rival to the wire. BABA'S MANDATE chased the pace, rallied to reach even terms for command at the sixteenth pole and just missed. ONE HOT TODDY reserved off the pace, altered course outside the leaders in the stretch for racing room and was gaining at the finish. SICILIAN HONOR outran early, raced three wide around the turn and closed with a belated rally. CINQUE BELLA saved ground around the turn and had no late response. ANOTHER FAST CAT sprinted to a clear lead while angling over to the inside, increased her advantage around the turn, made the pace to the sixteenth pole, then gave way. FRESH CALL was not a factor. CUT IT UP was done early.
