Footnotes

EL COBRE stalked the pace along the rail, was caught in tight soon after entering the far turn, slipped through inside TEPEYAC in the stretch, then rallied to be up late. QUE RICO rated off the pace after breaking slowly, advanced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole, made the pace to past the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner late. TEPEYAC set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run and gave way. OSUNA reserved in striking position off the pace, tired in the drive. TRADER JOHN allowed to settle, was saving ground when steadied to avoid running up on a rival leaving the far turn and failed to threaten. HOWARD'S EDGE taken in hand early, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat, then faltered in the drive. SICCARDI off slowly, was not a factor. MYTURNTOROCK chased the pace to midway of the far turn, then faded. HAVE FAITH IN ME was outrun. FIVE QUART ducked in at the start, then steadied along the inside on the first turn and was through after six furlongs. KEEP TO THE CODE was outrun after breaking slowly. FILLY CHASER showed speed for a half mile, stopped and was pulled up in the stretch.
