**Footnotes**

MOST CHARMING vied for the lead, along the inside on the turn, bumped with CHASE THE CHARMER as she slipped through in midstretch, took over inside the eighth pole and held the late gaining JUCKYANUNOIT sway under urging. LUCKYANUNOIT tracked the speed, four wide on the turn, was gaining late but couldn't get to the winner in time. CHASE THE CHARMER set the pace under pressure from both ROYLA LACE and MOST CHARMING while off the rail, bumped with the latter in the stretch and gave way in the final eighth. TECHNICAL QUESTION passed tired rivals after being in tight at the start. ROYAL LACE contested the pace three wide and weakened in the drive. MECKE ME PROUD drove up the rail into contention on the backstretch then dropped back entering the turn. JANE'S HALO pulled up on the backstretch and vanned off.
