MYSTERIOUS LIGHT rated off the pace, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run, rallied to catch STORM FORCAST just inside the eighth pole and edged away under urging. STORM FORCAST vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. JEAN DE ACTRESS outrun early, passed tired rivals for the show. RUTHLESS REBECCA failed to menace. LUCKISALADY vied for the lead outside STORM FORCAST to the top of the stretch, then tired. OH PEGGY SUE stalked the pace three wide into the far turn and faltered. DIG FOR DINNER showed early foot and faded.
