TALENTED PRINCESS reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and drew clear. BIANCA'S JEWEL reserved racing along the inside, angled out on the far turn and rallied to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. SOUTHCOTE ROAD unhurried early, angled to the outside in the stretch and closed with a belated rally for the show. SUTHERLAND was stalking the pace when her rider lost his whip on the far turn, eased out and made a run to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole, then tired. CHRISSY'S HONOR chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, maintained her advantage to past the eighth pole, then faltered. DEARDINNER set the pace under pressure along the rail, responded when headed by CHRISSY'S HONOR on the far turn, then faded in the final eighth. WALKINFORKISSES off slowly, was not a factor. FLIPAWAY pressed the pace outside DEARDINNER, was caught in tight entering the far turn and had nothing left.
