Footnotes

LONGER TERMS DOUG rated off the pace after being steadied at the start, saved ground to nearing the stretch, angled out and rallied to catch HONOR'S GOLD nearing the sixteenth pole, then was all out to hold off SHERIFF IRA. The latter, reserved racing off the rail, angled inside LONGER TERMS DOUG soon after entering the stretch and finished willingly for the place while unable to catch the winner. JOEY'S NIGHT RIDER chased the pace three wide, eased to the inside leaving the turn while making a run to loom a threat inside the eighth pole but was outfinished by the top ones. TWISTED ROSE stalked the early pace three wide, dropped back racing around the turn, then closed ground late without threatening. HONOR'S GOLD showed speed off the rail, drew clear around the turn, made the pace to nearing the sixteenth pole, then tired. PLATINUM FLIPFLOPS failed to menace. EL SPEEDO was through early.
