Footnotes

CRAFTY DIVA unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch FRIENDLY THERESA at the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. FRIENDLY THERESA chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over soon after entering the turn but couldn't hold off the winner late. BLOWN SURPRISE tracked the pace off the rail, made a run at the leaders along the inside in the stretch but didn't do enough late. HUMMEL off slowly, chased the pace along the rail, angled out for the stretch run and tired. DINNER SWEETS raced three wide on the turn and faltered. EVA'S PROSPECTOR sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the turn, then faded in the drive.
