IZTLA unhurried early, was angled to the inside midway of the turn, then rallied along the rail to be up in time. UCHITA showed speed along the inside, opened a clear lead in the stretch while coming off the inside, then just failed to last. LEONA'S KNIGHT reserved off the pace, raced four wide on the turn, then drifted out through the stretch run and closed with a belated rally for the show. SPECIAL REPORT outrun after hitting her head leaving the gate tearing her blinkers loose which her rider removed soon after the start, finished willingly in the drive. ISSUES chased the leaders four wide around the turn and gave way. NO HEAR SAY chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. MERTIE M pressed the pace outside UCHITA, then faltered in the drive.
