### Footnotes

LIL JOHN PAUL off slowly, advanced along the inside around the turn, angled outside the leaders for the stretch run and rallied to be just up at the wire. UNTAMEABLE broke awkwardly, chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over at the top of the stretch and edged clear, then just failed to last. POSITIVE ACTION reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and closed with a mild rally to gain the show. LEGENDARY STORM allowed to settle, angled wide in the stretch and passed tired rivals without threatening. DAZZLE ME DANNY tracked the leaders off the rail into the stretch and gave way. FAVORITE PRANK broke slowly, then failed to menace while racing four wide. DONDE ANDAS quickly sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then tired. BIG SKY GUY tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. GUIDING SPIRIT was outrun. MORNING GLASS showed early foot and faded.
