KANTURK KID outran HAPPY TO BE HERE around the first turn for the lead, made the pace off the rail, drew clear in midstretch, then was all out to hold sway. DEFEND stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch and finished willingly to edge SYMPHONY FORTY ONE for the place. The latter, stalked the pace three wide, was outmoved into the stretch, then came on again under pressure to just miss the place. HAPPY TO BE HERE chased the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, then gave way. NARVAEZ was not a factor. TRINITY TAVERN rated off the pace after bumping hard with CITY OF WESTON entering the first turn, saved ground around the far turn and tired. CITY OF WESTON reserved after being checked when he bumped with TRINITY TAVERN entering the first turn, raced three wide and faltered. REY ROCKET was done early and eased in the final eighth. HARD WORKING DAN was outrun and eased in the stretch run.
