Footnotes

TRISHA'S TROVE stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the turn then took over command in the stretch and drew clear late under a steady drive. LAKE DRIVE SOUTH chased the pace early, while on the inside into the turn then made a bid in the stretch from the rail but hung in the late stages. GEORGE JET was well placed early, angled into the four path in the turn and moved up in the stretch run. MAYHEM MAN threw his head at the start and trailed the field early, angled into the five path in the turn with a late run in the stretch but to no avail. RIGHT ON COURSE set the pace early, while on the inside into the turn and gave way in the stretch drive. CROWN DISTINCTION broke slowly at the start an swung into the six path entering the lane. SUBSTRAIGHT was never a factor. BIGOLBRU was done early. CL PRINCE was through after a half.
