LA SABANA chased the pace three wide, rallied to catch DAWN PRINCESA at the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. POPPOPS DORIANNE reserved off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and closed to be up for the place. DAWN PRINCESA made the pace off the rail to midstretch and weakened. VAL'S PRINCESS outrun early, passed tired rivals. SLIDE THE DRESSER failed to menace. CAGEY MOVE chased the pace around the turn and tired. PAULA JOHNSON hustled into contention along the rail after breaking in the air, chased the leaders to the top of the stretch and faltered. YIRA showed little. DINNER ROSE dwelt badly at the start and was never close.
