**Footnotes**

DUCK THE PUNT tracked the pace, angled outside the leaders for the drive, rallied to reach even terms for command just inside the eighth pole, was outmoted by NEUF LA BANQUE, then came on again under pressure to be just up at the wire. NEUF LA BANQUE (PER) unhurried early, split rivals while rallying through traffic in the stretch, gained a slim lead nearing the sixteenth pole, then just failed to last. BEST PRIZE rated off the pace, angled out at the top of the stretch, made a run to reach near even terms for command just past the eighth pole but wasn't good enough. TINA SUE set the pace along the rail to midstretch and weakened. ICANSEECLEARLY steadied in the run to the first turn, raced close up while saving ground into the stretch and lacked a late response. ARDENT LOVER allowed to settle, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MISS BO BLUSH reserved along the rail, was attempting to rally when forced to check inside ICANSEECLEARLY approaching the eighth pole and failed to recover. SLACKS broke poorly, raced in striking position three wide around the far turn and tired. CRISTAL LOVE was never a factor. C. R. PACE chased the pacesetter into the stretch and faltered.
