FAST JAK chased the pace, rallied to gain command at the quarter pole, then drew off under urging. LYNCH reserved off the pace, saved ground to past midway of the turn, angled out for the drive and closed to be just up for the place while no match for the winner. GARDEN TOUR chased the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, then couldn't keep pace with the winner while just being edged for the place. JAY ARTHUR tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. ROCKIN ROBBIE showed speed along the inside, then couldn't stay with the winner racing into the stretch and gave way in the final eighth. CRIMSON STREAK was never a factor. WIRE CUTTER was outrun. UNTAMEABLE raced in striking position to midway of the turn, then faltered. TRAINMAN chased the pace three wide into the turn and faded.
