MAJESTIC EXPRESS pressed the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the backstretch, responded when headed by HOLD THAT CAMERA in the stretch and came back on to prevail. HOLD THAT CAMERA stalked the pace three wide, made a run to gain a brief lead in the stretch but was outgamed to the wire. SASSARION reserved after breaking slowly, saved ground into the far turn, angled three wide for racing room and finished willingly to be up for the show. LIV N' RUN unhurried early, advanced along the rail around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch but didn't do enough late. LIQUID LUCK stalked the leaders into the stretch and weakened. SLEW DEM rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and tired. THREEHIFIVES was never a factor. FOLK SINGER set the pace along the inside to nearing the far turn, then faltered. PLEASANT ALBERT was done early.
