MISS SANDY DEE, stalked the pace, made a bid on the turn but was no match for the winner while holding the place. NOT TOO BLUE, bumped and steadied early, rallied into the stretch and was gaining on the runner-up while no threat to the winner. PRINCESS BABE, bumped and squeezed back at the start, passed tired rivals. MY LUCKY GAL, bumped at the start, lacked the needed rally. TILTALADY failed to menace after being bumped early. ISLAND BEAUTY checked early and again on the turn, was not a factor. RACING FOR PAHM chased the pace into the turn and tired. S. S. FINESSE well placed early, stopped.
