ADOBE GOLD reserved after being steadied from between rivals on the first turn, advanced along the inside on the far turn, eased outside SNIFFLES entering the stretch and rallied to open a clear lead, then was under a strong hand ride to hold NAJIBES ACRE safe. The latter, tracked the pace, raced four wide on the far turn, was outmoved by ADOBE GOLD entering the stretch, then was gaining on that rival late. SNIFFLES chased the pace along the rail, slipped through inside MARNESIA LIGHT to gain the lead on the far turn but was outfinished. SIERRA LADY outrun after hesitating at the start, passed tired rivals and finished on even terms with CHASE GAP. The latter, unhurried early, improved her position and dead heated with SIERRA LADY. NEVER FAIL was not a factor. EASY LASSIE chased the pace three wide into the far turn and tired. MARNESIA LIGHT set the pace off the rail into the far turn and faltered. TUSCANY LIGHT rated off the pace, faded leaving the far turn and was eased late.
