ALPHA GLITTER tracked the pace, angled outside the leaders in the stretch, rallied to take over in deep stretch, then just lasted over SURELY SENT. The latter, reserved off the pace, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to just miss. MORGANS BOY rated off the pace, angled out and rallied between the top ones to also just miss. TAXES TAXES TAXES vied for the lead outside SAFETY SQUEEZE to deep stretch, then yielded to the top ones in the final strides. SAFETY SQUEEZE vied for the lead along the rail to deep stretch and weakened. SWINGMAN tracked the leaders into the stretch and was outfinished. FOOLISH HONOR raced three wide and failed to menace. BESSELINK was outrun.
