Footnotes

TANNERSVILLE unhurried early, angled four wide on the far turn, rallied to gain command at the eighth pole, then drew off. GULF RUCKUS set the pace along the rail, came out a bit in early stretch, then drifted back to the inside impeding BLACK SCORPION approaching the eighth pole and was no match for the winner while holding the place. BLACK SCORPION rated off the pace, was racing between horses when steadied on the backstretch, moved to the inside leaving the far turn, was attempting to rally along the rail when checked to avoid GULF RUCKUS nearing the eighth pole and failed to recover. BROADWAY ACTOR chased the pace, made a run to try the leader racing into the far turn but couldn't stay with that rival and gave way in the drive. MAGIC MECKE reserved off the pace, made a run three wide to reach contention on the far turn, then tired. FAIR WEATHER STAN reserved racing along the rail, was steadied when caught in behind the fading BARRY'S MONEY on the far turn, then steadied again to avoid BLACK SCORPION in the stretch and faltered. BARRY'S MONEY chased the pace, made a run at the leader racing down the backstretch, then faded. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of BLACK SCORPION, GULF RUCKUS was disqualified and placed third for interference to that rival in the stretch.
