Footnotes

MUCHO MAS MACHO unhurried early, rallied four wide around the far turn to take over racing into the stretch, then drew off. DIRECTION TO PAY bumped with SILVER DISTINCTION at the start, vied for the lead along the inside, edged away entering the far turn but was no match for the winner in the drive while holding the place. SILVER DISTINCTION rated off the pace after being bumped between rivals at the start, raced four wide around the far turn and couldn't keep pace with the top ones. BLANDISHING outrun early, circled rivals five wide to reach contention leaving the far turn, then tired. MY BAMBINO reserved early, made a run three wide around the far turn to reach the attending position approaching the quarter pole, then gave way. EMPIRE BUILDER bumped with SILVER DISTINCTION at the start, tracked the pace off the rail to the quarter pole and faltered. SOLICITATION tracked the pace for a half mile, then faded. TRITONK broke in the air, then was no factor while racing five wide. CONGRATS CRIMINAL tracked the pace along the rail to the far turn, then had nothing left. CHIAPPINI vied for the lead outside DIRECTION TO PAY to nearing the far turn, then stopped.
