RAVELO'S BOY reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the turn, then rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. HERE WE GO JOE allowed to settle, angled out in the stretch, then closed in close quarters to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. FEARSOME TIGER tracked the pace, rallied to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole while drifting out under left-handed pressure and couldn't resist the top ones. REX'S LAST TOUR unhurried early, was advancing along the rail when steadied to avoid running up on KANAVAYEN in stretch, recovered and finished willingly. TIGLON off slowly, was outrun early, then gained some ground without threatening. SKIBO IN JULY dueled for the lead along the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then tired. KANAVAYEN dueled for the lead outside SKIBO IN JULY into the stretch, then faltered. TURBO CANNON chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN. NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
