ALLENDAR saved ground into the stretch, angled outside the leaders and rallied under pressure to draw clear late. LINEAR MARK pressed the pace along the rail and was up for the place in the final strides. SUNMIST set the pace under pressure to inside the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. CANNON WHIRL reserved early, angled out at the top of the stretch and closed with a mild response. INHALE chased the pace three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. INVOICE saved ground throughout and lacked a rally. FIGHTING FURY was outrun. MINDY MCHUBBLE was through early. TRY N PASS trailed.
