OROQUE vied for the lead outside THE PIA ANGEL, edged clear from that rival in early stretch, then was all out to just last over DARE TO DOUBLE. The latter, chased the pace along the inside, angled three wide midway of the turn, then rallied to just miss. MINNIE SUNSHINE rated off the pace after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the turn, then closed well along the outside to just miss catching the top ones. KATE'S HOLIDAY reserved early, raced off the rail, then responded to pressure in the drive and was gaining on the top ones at the wire. MY ROLEX chased the leaders into the stretch and gave way. MANAKCO STAR clipped heels with SECRET BLITZ racing down the backstretch and failed to menace. TRIPPI'S SAILOR chased the pace to midway of the turn, then tired. THE PIA ANGEL vied for the lead along the inside to past midway of the turn, then faltered. SECRET BLITZ was no factor while racing four wide. ALTAMAR trailed after breaking a step slowly.
