REFLECTED CAT reserved along the hedge, advanced into contention around the far turn, altered course outside the leaders at the eighth pole, then rallied to be just up at the wire. KIJO set the pace along the hedge, responded when headed by MAGNIFICENT TIGER on the far turn, regained the lead at the top of the stretch, then just failed to last. MAGNIFICENT TIGER chased the pace, moved to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. HOOPLA stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and had no response when asked. IKE'S BOY chased the pace, was steadied from tight quarters when attempting to split the leaders entering the far turn, continued to chase the pace, then steadied again at the top of the stretch when caught in behind the top ones and gave way. SOUPER MOON saved ground and failed to menace. KING PRADA off slowly, was never a threat. TAPITS MAIN MAN reserved after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. ZEPHYR LIGHT chased the pace along the inside around the far turn and faltered. V I MONGOOSE off slowly, faded on the far turn. GENERAL GUTI was outrun.
