Footnotes

CROSS THE ATLANTIC stalked the pace off the rail, was steadied in tight quarters when ALKAZABITO came out at the top of the stretch, recovered and rallied under pressure to be up late. ALKAZABITO set the pace along the inside, responded when BRIDLED QUEST moved to the fore soon after entering the far turn, came back on to regain the lead while coming out a bit at the top of the stretch, edged to a clear advantage but couldn't resist the winner late. BRIDLED QUEST bumped with DUG IN at the start, chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead after entering the far turn, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then weakened. DUG IN reserved after being bumped and steadied from between rivals at the start, circled rivals four wide around the far turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then gave way. SWEETLANDOFLIBERTY unhurried early, swung five wide while moving into contention on the far turn, then tired in the drive. YOMBO MAUGERE was not a factor. CHARKO bumped with DUG IN at the start, tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then faltered. CHAPEL RUN chased the pace along the rail for a half mile, then faded.
