COOPER'S CURRENT chased the pace, moved to take over in early stretch and was all out to prevail. TWILIGHT MIRAGE set the pace along the inside into the stretch and held on well while being edged to the wire. SOCIAL TOP rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and outfinished the others while unable to gain on the top ones. FABULOUS FOX reserved early, raced four wide on the turn and lacked a rally. QUON was outrun. IT'S A CUBAN THING raced in striking position off the rail into the stretch and tired. ARIANNA'S SONG was never a factor. COOLASSAM showed early foot, then bore out around the turn and faded.
