PICK OF THE PACK unhurried after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. LADYINAREDDRESS checked from tight quarters along the inside on the first turn, advanced into contention three wide on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead approaching the sixteenth pole but was edged to the wire in the closing strides. MALINDI reserved early, advanced into contention four wide on the far turn but couldn't stay with the top ones while gaining the show. QUEEN GERALDINE set the pace off the rail to past the eighth pole and gave way. ATLANTIC SNOW was no factor after being outrun early. BLUSHINGKITTENTALE chased the pacesetter into the far turn and tired. MISS GINALIE chased the pace along the inside to the far turn and faltered. JULES FOR A. J. chased the pace to nearing the stretch and faded.
