TAP DANCER steadied racing into the first turn, advanced into contention three wide on the far turn, then drifted to the inside while rallying to catch CHARMING JIM at the sixteenth pole and edged away. CHARMING JIM prompted the pace outside TWICE AS BAD, took over from that rival leaving the far turn but couldn't stay with the winner late while holding the place. HOPEFORTHROSES rated in striking position off the pace, eased out in the stretch and closed to be up for the show. BROADWAY VIEW allowed to settle, passed tired rivals without threatening. IMPERIALISM unhurried early, improved his position in the drive. SECOND OF JUNE was no factor after breaking poorly. ECONOMIST AT LAST chased the leaders three wide into the far turn and tired. TWICE AS BAD set the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. PLEASANT HONOR was bothered when TAP DANCER steadied racing into the first turn, then was through after a half mile. FORMAL PASS well place while saving ground, faded in the drive.
