### Footnotes

IT'S A BIRD tracked the pace, moved up to engage B L'S A RUNNER on the far turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and edged away. B L'S A RUNNER set the pace along the inside, responded when challenged by IT'S A BIRD on the far turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and yielded. MR. UNSTOPPABLE outrun early, raced four wide around the far turn and closed to be up for the show. ALY'S WHEAT reserved while saving ground, steadied in behind rivals on the far turn, then didn't do enough late. MAMBO MEISTER allowed to settle after breaking slowly, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat but had no further response. GREEN VEGAS tracked the leaders along the inside into the far turn and tired. LOST CONQUEST was not a factor. CURIOUS TIGER stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, then faltered. QUISTOPHER pressed the pace for a half mile, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
