Footnotes

MS BLOOMFIELD HIGH tracked the pace after being caught in tight at the start, split rivals to take over on the backstretch, made the pace off the rail, responded when challenged by MIDNIGHT SCRIMMAGE at the sixteenth pole and repulsed that rival to prevail. MIDNIGHT SCRIMMAGE reserved racing along the inside, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to reach even terms for command with MS BLOOMFIELD HIGH at the sixteenth pole but was outgamed to the wire. JULIEANNAMO stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. PUMPIDU raced with the pace for more than a half mile, then gave way. TAKER HOME rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. MARIJA'S WISH steadied leaving the first turn, raced in striking position to past midway of the far turn and faltered. DIAMONDESQUE set the pace along the rail into the backstretch, then couldn't stay with the winner and faded in the drive.
