FREE THE MAGIC unhurried while saving ground, was advancing into contention along the rail on the far turn when blocked at the top of the stretch, angled out for room and rallied to be up late. LAUREL LIGHT reserved in striking position off the pace, angled wide in the stretch and closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by FREE THE MAGIC. SLACKS well placed, angled to the rail at the top of the stretch, made a run to loom a threat in midstretch but didn't do enough late while gaining the show. RAPONERA chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. FROZEN DINNER rated off the pace, advanced to reach the leaders three wide on the far turn, continued on well to deep stretch and gave way. FRENCH MADAM allowed to settle, rallied four wide on the far turn, gained a slim lead in the stretch, then tired. VERY EARLY SCOTCH hit the gate at the start and was outrun. VEGAS ALARM stumbled at the start, moved up to make the pace along the inside into the far turn and faltered.
