LAWBOOK rated off the pace, rallied three wide around the turn to gain command at the top of the stretch, then drew away under urging. SUPAH BLITZ allowed to settle, advanced three wide around the turn and closed to prove second best while unable to keep pace with the winner. THE NAME'S BOND chased the pace off the rail, moved to reach even terms for command soon after entering the turn, then tired in the drive. RUFUSTHEROADRUNNER chased the pace three wide, moved to take over on the turn and opened a clear lead, then gave way in the drive after his rider lost his whip leaving the turn. NOMADIC ACTOR saved ground and faltered. KISSIN BOLD showed speed along the inside into the turn and faded. INDIAN CRUSADER trailed while saving ground. TRUST N LUCK wheeled at the start and unseated his rider.
