COQUINERIE off slowly, was outrun into the far turn, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to be just up at the wire. WEKIVA MIST reserved while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn and rallied inside COQUINERIE to just miss. SUPAH JACKIE chased the pace along the inside, angled three wide on the far turn and rallied to take over, drew well clear in the stretch, then shortened stride late and failed to last. OUTRAGEOUS QUEEN set the pace along the inside into the far turn and tired. LAU MOR'S GLITTER chased the pace off the rail into the far turn and faltered. LIBERTY'S TORCH was not a factor. STORMIN' DAINA was outrun. I'M DANCING showed early foot, faded and was eased in the stretch run. ARTSY showed little after breaking slowly and was eased in the stretch run.
