SCOTTISH BUBBLY stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead just inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. GENTILE ALOUETTE reserved off the pace while saving ground, rallied along the inside to reach the winner inside the eighth pole and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. ME GOTTA GO chased the pace off the rail, rallied to take over on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. FIDGET unhurried early, passed tired rivals without threatening. HANNAH'S TEMPER outrun early, improved her position in the drive. URBANA LIGHT quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside into the far turn and tired. SIERRA LADY was never a factor. MS BROOKSKI allowed to settle, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. VAGUE MEMORY tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn and faltered. LIGHT DANCER bobbled at the start and was done early.
