OFFICER'SGENTLEMAN stalked the pace three wide, moved to take over on the far turn, then drew away while drifting to the inside. NUMBER TWO SON reserved off the pace, rallied around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but was no match for the winner while clearly best of the rest. JOHANNESBURG PLACE unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals for the show. BRAVE APACHE showed speed off the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. RAYO DE LUZ showed brief speed along the rail and faltered. AFLEET'S SECRET was outrun. BRONSON broke slowly, then was caught wide around the first turn, chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faded. TRISTAN'S PAL was done early and eased in the final eighth.
