JEAN DE ACTRESS rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and rallied to be just up at the wire. CLEVER DAME bumped with SNEAKY BUNNIE at the start, showed speed along the inside, drew clear in the stretch, then just failed to last. DIG FOR DINNER chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then gave way. TRAIN TO GLORY chased the pace, then was tiring when checked midway of the turn. SNEAKY BUNNIE bumped and steadied at the start, raced three wide around the turn and failed to menace. MARK ME bumped hard with MADISON NORTH at the start, tracked the pace along the rail into the stretch and faltered. NO PUSSYCAT showed early foot, was fading along the rail when steadied midway of the turn. MATCHBOOK bumped soundly with MADISON NORTH at the start, showed brief speed and dropped back. MADISON NORTH trailed after being bumped and checked from between rivals at the start.
