COMMIT ME bumped with MISS VALID JOANN at the start, was reserved off the pace, three wide around the turn, gained command at the furlong marker and drew off while being kept to pressure. BOOK THE BULLET unhurried early, closed four wide on the turn to be up for the place. LOST QUESTION allowed to settle, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. SHOW US THE CHECK forced the pace off the rail, took over nearing the quarter pole and gave way in the final eighth. MISS VALID JOANN bumped with the winner at the start, in good position, off the rail around the turn, weakened in the drive. YOU ARE STORMY tracked the speed, four wide on the turn and tired in the stretch run. GOLDBROOK set the pace along the inside under pressure from SHOW US THE CHECK to nearing the quarter pole and faltered. GEM LEA trailed.
