Footnotes

I AIN'T NO SAINT moved up along the rail to contest the early pace, dueled heads apart for a half, opened a clear lead in upper stretch and drew off under steady urging. THE TRADER was unhurried early, rallied along the rail on the turn, clipped heels and stumbled at he quarter pole, made a run to threaten in midstretch then drifted out considerably in the final eighth. DIAMONDS ARE IN settled in the middle of the pack to the turn, lodged a mild rally from outside to reach contention in upper stretch and flattened out. TOOT AND GO dueled outside the winner for a half and tired. BULLET PROOF MAN failed to mount a serious rally. SUDDEN ROCK raced wide to the turn and faded in the stretch. CASH MCCOOL chased three wide for a half and tired. LEFTY YATES never reached contention.
