FATHER LUCEY set the pace along the inside, repulsed a bid from PERFECT CHEROKEE around the far turn and into the stretch, then drew clear. PERFECT CHEROKEE stalked the pace off the rail, made a run to try FATHER LUCEY midway of the far turn and into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival in the final eighth while holding the place. KRIS AND ME unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied for the show. CAPT. ZIPPOUNAS hustled to get position, stalked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then tired. FALSE ECONOMY tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn and faltered. BESSELINK was through early.
