**Footnotes**

ROAD TO BABYLON set the pace under pressure along the rail into the far turn, then drew clear under urging. SILVER DISTINCTION rated off the pace after being caught in tight at the start, raced three wide around the far turn and closed with a mild response to be up for the place. BALTIMORE SAINT outran early, angled out on the far turn, rallied to reach the attending position at the sixteenth pole but was outgamed for the place. RATTLESNAKE RED reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, advanced three wide down the backstretch to reach the leaders, tried ROAD TO BABYLON to midway of the far turn, then tired. HOPEFULLY LUCKY pressed the pace outside ROAD TO BABYLON into the far turn, then faltered. JACKWAGON raced four wide and failed to threaten. KARMANOS was never a factor. BATTLE MUSIC stalked the pace to midway of the far turn, then faded. VAPOR TRACE was through early.
