RED HILLS stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then edged away under pressure. I GO THROUGH tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to reach near even terms for command with RED HILLS at the eighth pole but couldn't stay with that rival while proving best of the rest. MIZE THE BIG CAT chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. THE BRAVEHEART set the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn and tired. TYLER'S WILDCAT raced three wide and faltered. WHAZAMUDDER U tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn, then faded. DRINKS TO GO was outrun.
