Footnotes

MYLITTA rated off the pace after breaking awkwardly, eased out and rallied three wide to take over soon after entering the stretch, then was all out to last over I KNOW IT ALL. The latter, steadied in the run to the first turn, stalked the pace along the rail, angled out at the top of the stretch, then rallied to just miss. HOLLY TRICK allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and closed well for the show. MUCHO MANS GOLD pressed the pace outside COJO'S LOCO into the stretch, then gave way. SENTENCIADA was not a factor. COJO'S LOCO set the pace under pressure along the rail into the stretch and tired. SERETARIA stalked the pace four wide to nearing the top of the stretch, then faltered. GIVONNA B was through after six furlongs. CONCIERTO IMPERIAL stalked the pace off the rail into the far turn and faded. TICKET TO PARADISE was outrun.
