ALICE'S NOTEBOOK vied for the lead, moved to the inside on the turn when RICH CELEBRATION dropped back, continued to vie with BEST OF THE REST to deep stretch and was fully extended to prevail. BEST OF THE REST vied for the lead outside ALICE'S NOTEBOOK to deep stretch and continued on with good courage while being outfinished. SILVER JET chased the pace into the stretch but couldn't gain late. DIAMOND STUDS showed speed from the outside, raced three wide around the turn and weakened. RICH CELEBRATION showed early speed, raced along the rail and tired. CALLIE AND JAKE was no factor after breaking poorly. DANCE THE BALLADO off slowly, was outrun. DE' FLIGHT showed little after breaking slowly. SPECIAL MOMENTS raced four wide on the turn and faded.
