MR. LIVINGSTON never far back while saving ground, angled outside the leader in the stretch and rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. HONORABLE PIC set the pace along the hedge and continued on gamely while just failing to last. PISCES unhurried early, saved ground and closed well along the hedge for the show. BAND IS PASSING tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. MR. PLEASANTFAR (BRZ) outrun early, lacked a late response. HAL'S HOPE stalked the pace, made a run at HONORABLE PIC racing into the far turn, then faltered. FAPPIE'S NOTEBOOK was outrun. HIGH IDEAL raced in striking position to nearing the far turn, then faded.
