NEWS CARRIER vied for the lead along the inside, edged away in midstretch, then drifted out late and just lasted over BAYSTREET BULLY. The latter, allowed to settle, angled out for room in the stretch and rallied to just miss. EASTERN SEABOARD rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. FLINT MOUNTAIN tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. WINAWAY failed to menace. STARSHIP VOYAGE vied for the lead outside NEWS CARRIER into the stretch, then tired. PENDER'S TUNE bobbled at the start, saved ground and faded.
