MEDIA STARLETT rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the far turn to join the leaders, gained a slim advantage in early stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. EXCHANGE MISS tracked the pace, eased to the inside on the far turn and was gaining slowly on the winner at the finish. INVISIBLE VISION set the pace off the rail into the stretch, then gave way grudgingly. STARSHIP BALLERINA tracked the pace along the rail into the far turn and tired. TRIPPI'S VALENTINE stalked the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. VERY VERY CLEVER was not a factor. FLORIDA WILDCAT reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and faded.
