**Footnotes**

BARTOLOME stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through inside SARAVA'S DANCER to gain command on the far turn, then drew away under pressure. SARAVA'S DANCER pressed the pace outside FLYING APTITUDE, took over from that rival racing down the backstretch, made the pace off the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. EL ROMANO reserved racing off the rail, passed tired rivals for the show. DANCE WITH MONARCH stalked the pace, moved up three wide with SARAVA'S DANCER racing down the backstretch, tried that rival to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. FLYING APTITUDE set the pace off the rail into the backstretch, then faltered. LITTLE NICHOLAS raced three wide and was done early. SWAN BLACK was outrun. ALTARATION off slowly, was never close.
