Footnotes

MISS MUFFIN stalked the pace, split rivals entering the far turn to gain the lead, opened a clear advantage racing into the stretch, then was all out to hold off HANNAH'S PRINCESS. The latter, rated off the pace, angled in to save ground while advancing around the far turn, then responded to pressure and was gaining on the winner at the finish. ROBIN'S COMMANDER outrun after being pinched back at the start, raced four wide around the far turn and rallied to be up for the show. QUEEN OF PEARLS reserved off the pace, advanced into contention around the far turn but didn't do enough late. JUST ME N YOU allowed to settle, passed tired rivals in the drive. CONSOLACION SUR unhurried early, raced three wide around the far turn and improved her position without threatening. FAN DAME taken in hand early, advanced to reach contention on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. LOURDES MY LOVE prompted the pace to the far turn, then tired. SERENE LIGHT tracked the leaders four wide to nearing the stretch and faltered. ALTAMAR set the pace

along the hedge to nearing the end of the backstretch, then was fading when steadied on the far turn and continued to drop back. PRINCESS GRACE stumbled at the start, chased the pace three wide to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. UNDISPUTED QUEEN steadied leaving the first turn, was through after a half mile and eased in the stretch run.
