Footnotes

SASTRE outran rivals three wide around the first turn to gain the lead, eased to the inside on the backstretch while making the pace into the stretch, then drew away under a hand ride. WAIKIKI unhurried early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach the attending position but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. BIG BAND stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch and gave way. ROOM MATE failed to menace. HUGO LIGHT raced with the pace between rivals around the first turn, was taken in hand to stalk the winner along the inside down the backstretch and around the far turn, then tired. GREAT BEAR was not a factor. ROCK GOD was pressing the pace along the rail when steadied back off the leaders leaving the first turn, remained in contention to midway of the far turn, then faltered. SARAVA STAR was through early.
